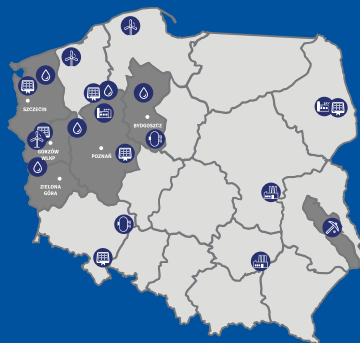

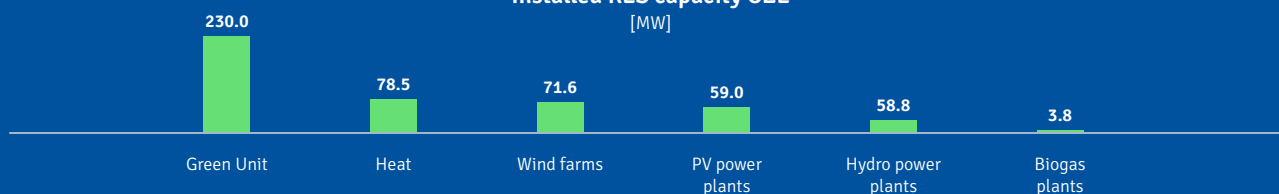

Distribution area of ENEA Operator

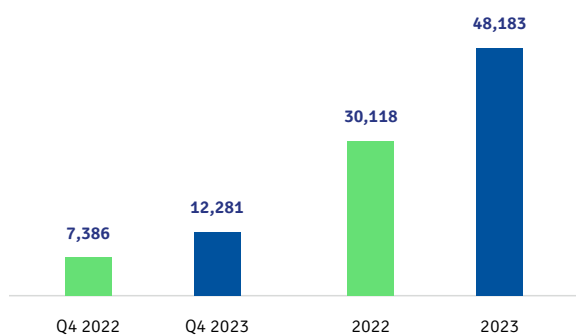
Installed RES capacity OZE [MW]



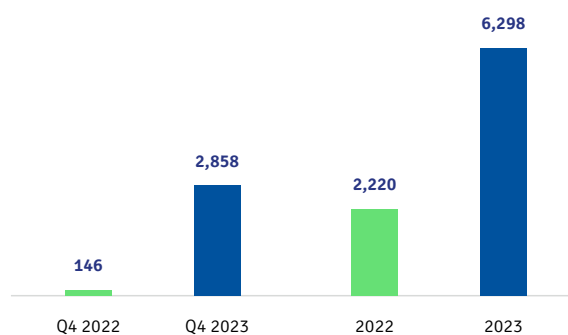

Revenue from sales and other income



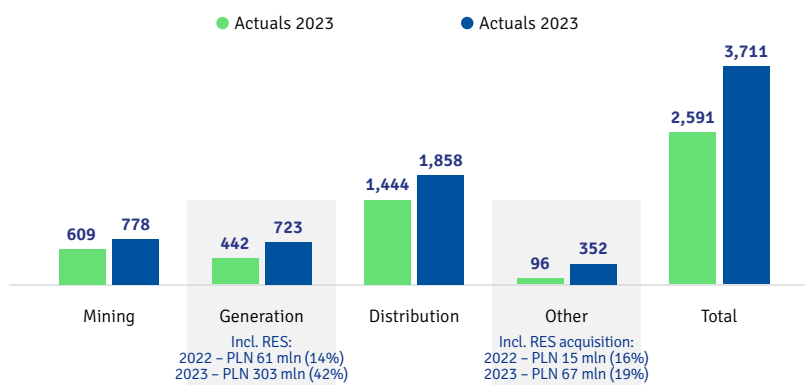
EBITDA
